But Anthony Ianni defied the predictions. He graduated from Michigan State University and became the first athlete with autism to play Division 1 college basketball.

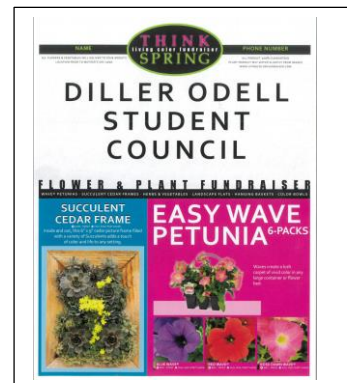
Now, Anthony is on a mission: to eradicate bullying and **inspire everyone** to "Live Your Dream."

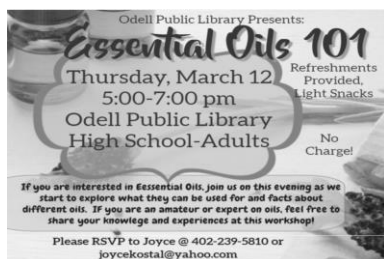
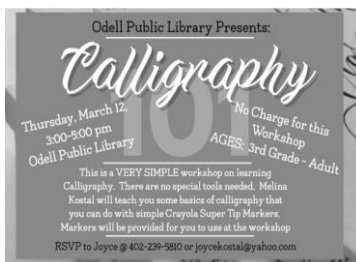
Week Two: Plan your meals each week!
