Public Health Solutions District Health Department will again be offering flu immunization clinics for students at your school and will be offering Covid-19 vaccines to anyone with a returned consent form who is 12 years and up. Prior to the start of clinics, students will bring home consent forms and fact sheets explaining the importance of receiving flu immunizations. For the Pfizer consent we have our vaccine fact sheet on our website: phsneb.org, we will also bring EUA fact sheets to the school for anyone who receives the Pfizer vaccine. Parents and guardians are encouraged to read the information carefully, complete and sign the consent form, and send it back to the school with their student.
