**Driver's Education:** Any students who have or will have a school, learner's, or provisional driver's permit: The Nebraska Safety Council of Lincoln is offering driver's education class this summer and would love to have you become a safer and more responsible driver. The online class provided by Triple A must be taken before the driving portion of the class. This takes 30-35 hours with tests and instruction and must be completed before driving. You then do the driving portion during the summer. This includes five hours of behind the wheel experience, five hours of back seat observation, and a 45 minute driving test.
